

The Berkshires Are Back HO Scale 2-8-4 Berkshire Steam Locomotives with DCC Sound Value® On Board



Developed as an improvement of the 2-8-2 Mikado design, the 2-8-4 Berkshire gained its iconic moniker while being tested on the tough grades of the Boston & Albany Railroad in the Berkshire Hills. From the mid-1920s to the early 1950s, Berkshires could be found throughout the East Coast and Upper Midwest, and following the steam era's demise, a handful of 2-8-4s returned to steam in mainline excursion service. These included C&O® #2716, Pere Marquette #1225, and Nickel Plate Road #759 and #765. Together with other notable steam survivors, these Berkshires were instrumental in keeping the romance of big steam alive in the American consciousness, and both Pere Marguette #1225 and Nickel Plate Road #765 continue to wow crowds in mainline excursion service to this day. Sounds include an authentic prototypical chuff, short and long whistles, bell, air pump, steam release, and blower effect. 
