
1960s and 70s Carriers Ready for Your Fleet

Inbound Auto Industry Freight to Pair With Outbound Cousins





In the early 1960s, auto makers approached freight car builders with the request to create the perfect boxcar for hauling heavy parts and this car was their answer. Their smooth sides hide interior posts where load restraints could be mounted. Large single doors provided easy access to load heavier cargo by forklift. Such loads included engine blocks, transmissions, brake drums, etcetera – and were carried via special baskets designed for the job. These 60' boxes were seen in priority train service moving to and from America's auto assembly plants, and they'll be ready to enter service on your layout this winter.

Milwaukee Road fans have been waiting a long time for the return of our HO scale Milwaukee Rib Side Caboose from WalthersProto®. Built in the 1930s through 40s, Milwaukee's prototype bay window caboose borrowed ideas from their freight and passenger car fleets of the time, using welded steel, ribbed sides to provide extra strength, and building the car atop passenger trucks originally designed for their 56' combines. Over the course of 15 years Milwaukee Road built 315 such cabooses, modernizing and updating them along the way. And they were long-lived with many units serving the road up to and past the 1985 Soo Line merger. The model is being offered in two different configurations and five paint schemes. It's well-detailed with wire grabs, separately applied ladders and exhaust stacks and a detailed underbody, and would make an handsome addition to the rear of Milwaukee Road freights.

Style and Sounds of Old-Time Railroading in HO from Bachmann



This Bachmann HO Scale <u>4-4-0</u> with <u>Wood Tender</u> is based on the fancy steam locomotives from North America's early days of railroading. Decorated in colorful schemes, locomotives like this were favorites from the mid-1800s and lasted into the early 1900s when replaced by much larger engines. This modern model of a vintage classic features a detailed injection-molded body, fine decoration and E-Z Mate(R) Mark II knuckle couplers. It performs best on 18" or larger radius curves. The Bachmann Sound Value steam locomotive is DCC-equipped with a SoundTraxx(R) decoder for sound, speed, direction, and lighting control, and is ready-to-run for either analog layout or DCC operation. The 4-4-0 with Wood Tender is one of many Bachmann HO Scale locomotives.

One of the Most Widely Used EMD Diesels in N Scale from Broadway Limited





The N Scale Broadway Limited <u>EMD SD40-2</u> with sound and DCC is based on one of the most popular diesels ever built. Introduced in the 1970s, reliable SD40-2s became the workhorse diesels used for everything from hauling 10,000-ton coal drags to short, fast intermodal trains. This diesel features full Paragon4 sound and DCC for realistic sound and motor control. The Paragon4 sound system works with all Broadway Limited Rolling Thunder(TM) advanced sound systems. Other features of this diesel locomotive include a heavy die cast chassis, smooth-running flywheel-equipped drive, directional lighting, magnetic knuckle couplers and low or high nose body as appropriate for each roadname. The N Scale EMD SD40-2 can be operated on all DCC systems as well as on standard DC railroads (with limited sound functionality). It has wheels profiled to operate on Code 55 and larger rail and curves of 9-3/4" radius and larger are recommended. The EMD SD40-2 is one of many Broadway Limited N Scale locomotives.




